1. WILDLIFE Mammals and birds	Praxim is not classified as ' <i>Harmful to game, wild birds and animals</i> '. No risk management is necessary to protect birds and mammals. Praxim is of low toxicity to birds and mammals. There is low risk to wild birds and mammals due to limited consumption of treated crops.
2. BEES	No risk management is necessary. Praxim is of low risk to bees.
3. NON TARGET INSECTS AND OTHER ARTHROPODS	No risk management is necessary. Praxim is of low risk to a range of arthropod species commonly found in and around treated fields.
4. AQUATIC LIFE	Praxim is classified as ' <i>very toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects</i> '. It is toxic to fish, daphnia and algae. Care should be taken to minimise drift when applying Praxim when near to ponds, ditches or slow flowing streams. Care should be taken to ensure that surface waters and ditches are not contaminated with product or used containers. Avoid contamination via drains from farmyards and roads.
5. SOIL AND GROUNDWATER Earthworms Soil micro-organisms	No risk management necessary. No risk management necessary. Praxim is of low toxicity to earthworms. No risk management necessary. At the recommended application rate, Praxim has no effects on soil microbial respiration or nitrogen turnover. The risk to soil microbial activity is therefore low.
6. NON-TARGET PLANTS	Take care to avoid drift onto neighbouring crops and non-agricultural land.
